In order to fill the races, some late entries may be accepted at the approval of the committee. NAPPA would like to invite non-NAPPA members to participate in the Lead Line Trot Races. Contact Regina at 410-340-2347. Reminder to all competetors, you must have an NSA or ASTM/SEI approved helmet to compete, current health insurance, and a protective vest and over girth. (Lead Line Trot entries must have health insurance and approved helmet, protective vest and over girth are highly reccomended, but not required.) Light refreshments for O/T/R's will be served after the last race.

Horseman will enter via GATE 2 and park where trailers normally park for the Gold Cup races. The Secretary booth will be underneath the Stewards Stand. Reminder that all riders in races who have assigned weights, you MUST weigh out and back in before and after the race. Marylee Quelero will be the Clerk of Scales. Scales are also located in the Secretary area. For directions visit www.greatmeadow.org

There will also be a Wine Festival right next to the races. Tickets may be purchased through NAPPA at a discounted price. Passes are not required to enter the horseman's gate, so you will not recieve anything in the mail. If you'd like to aquire a tailgate pass, contact Regina at the NAPPA office.
